

California Energy Commission Adopts Report Finding No Benefit from ATC

This week, the California Energy Commission (CEC) formally adopted its report finding that there are virtually no benefits — only costs — associated with requiring retailers to install automatic temperature compensation (ATC) devices on their fuel dispensers.

At the request of the California Legislature, for more than a year the CEC has conducted a comprehensive study on ATC. The results have been anxiously awaited by the National Conference on Weights and Measures, which will vote in July on whether to allow or mandate ATC.
